### Port Wakefield / Waterloo Corner Roads 8-10 February weekend works

As part of the Northern Connector Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that weekend works will be undertaken on Port Wakefield and Waterloo Corner Roads.

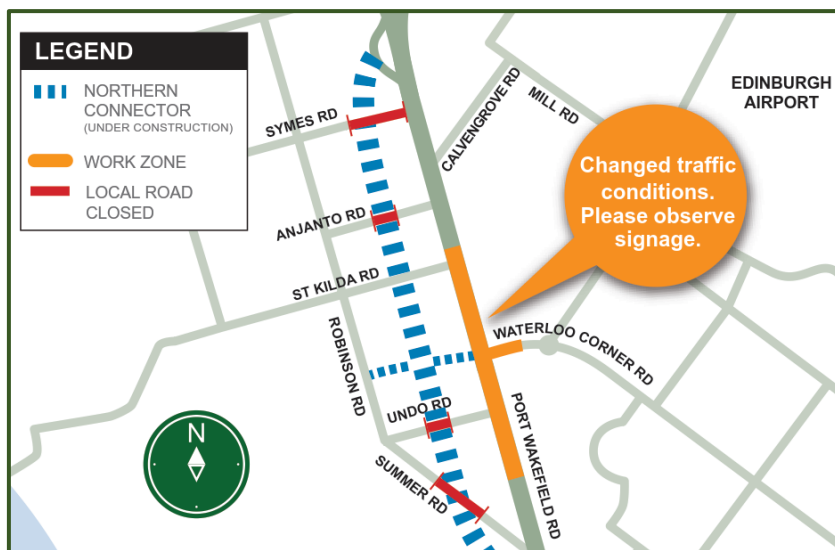
**Location:** Between Summer and Anjanto Roads (refer to map below).

**Work hours, weather permitting:**

- 7pm Friday 8 February, to 9am Saturday 9 February;
- 7pm Saturday 9 February, to 10am Sunday 10 February; and
- 6pm Sunday 10 February, to 5am Monday 11 February.

**Activities:** The first stage of road re-surfacing activities required for the Waterloo Corner Interchange

**Traffic management:** Traffic will be reduced to a **single lane in each direction** under managed traffic conditions. Traffic arrangements will change over the weekend, and signage and traffic management will be in place to advise motorists of changed conditions. Delays may be experienced so please plan ahead.
