TAPA MARTINTHI YALA Shared Use Path Opening at Southern Interchange & Dry Creek Trail

The final sections of the Tapa Martinthi Yala shared use path, at the Southern Interchange and Dry Creek Trail, will open on Saturday, 1 August. The opening of these final sections completes the connection to the Gawler Greenway.

The name of the path - Tapa Martinthi Yala - means "pathway to embrace today" in the Aboriginal Kaurna language and has been delivered as part of the Northern Connector Project. This path connects into the new Port River Bikeway and the Gawler Greenway at The Northern Connector's Southern Interchange, creating approximately 43km of continuous paths from Gawler to Port Adelaide.

People walking and cycling are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the below map and take care at the dedicated pedestrian crossings. You can also plan your bike ride on these new cycling facilities on the *Cycle Instead Journey Planner* cycleinstead.com.au


